The following question was received from a Request for Proposal (RFP) recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

1. **Question:** Are the selected consultant and sub-consultant(s) precluded from future work involving the Port Authority Bus Terminal capacity improvements?

**Answer:** If the Proposer or any employee, agent or sub-consultant of the Proposer may have a possible conflict of interest, or may give the appearance of a possible conflict of interest, the Proposer shall include in its proposal a statement indicating the nature of the conflict, and should include a plan for mitigating said conflict. While it is not presently contemplated that the selected firm will be precluded from further work, the Port Authority reserves the right to preclude the firm if, in its sole discretion the Port Authority determines a conflict exists. The Port Authority's determination regarding any questions of conflict of interest shall be final.
