SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL PLANNING, ARCHITECTURAL, AND ENGINEERING SERVICES TO PREPARE A MIDTOWN BUS MASTER PLAN ON AN “AS-NEEDED” BASIS (RFP #32797 – ADDENDUM #4)

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, hereby amends subject solicitation as follows:

At the bottom of Page 2 of the RFP cover letter, in the paragraph starting with “In the case of common law joint ventures...” delete the paragraph in its entirety, and replace it with the following:

“In the case of joint ventures: the prerequisites in subparagraphs A, B and C above will be considered satisfied if the joint venture itself, any of its participants individually or a combination of its participants, can collectively meet said prerequisites.

If a joint venture that has not been established as a distinct legal entity submits a Proposal, it and all participants in the joint venture shall be bound jointly and severally. Each such participant in the joint venture shall execute the Proposal and do each act and thing required by this solicitation.

If the joint venture Proposer is a distinct legal entity, the name of the joint venture should appear on the original Proposal and wherever else the Respondent’s name would appear.

If the Proposer is a common law joint venture (a partnership of 2 or more firms), the names of all participants should be listed followed by the words “acting jointly and severally.”

All joint venture Proposers must provide documentation of their legal status.”

The due date for receipt of proposals remains 2:00 p.m. on April 29, 2013.
