Question 1: In the RFP Letter, Section I. Proposer Requirements, do the Proposer Requirements apply to the prime firm only or can the requirements be met collectively as a team with our subconsultants?

Answer: The requirements can be met collectively as a team.

<u>Question 2</u>: In the RFP Letter, Section I. Proposer Requirements, for items A. and B., does "one of each type" mean at least one infrastructure and one landscape design project or one of each type of infrastructure project listed in the notation?

<u>Answer:</u> The design and construction portion is applicable to both the Infrastructure and Landscape categories, meaning proposers must demonstrate at least one project for infrastructure and one for landscape design projects.
