Title: Contract PAT-024.031: PATH REPLACEMENT OF SUBSTATION No. 7
(This RTQ supersedes previous solicitation advertised in April 2010 under the same Contract Number)

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The Contract referenced herein involves replacement and upgrade of PATH Substation No. 7 and removal of the existing PATH Substation No. 7. The scope of work includes construction of a two-story steel framed building for the new substation; furnishing, installation, and commissioning of three (3) 2000 kilowatt (KW) heavy duty traction power rectifiers, transformers, and switchgear; 38 kilovolt (KV) circuit breakers; medium voltage feeder cables; Direct Current (DC) switchgear; auxiliary power distribution system; Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and associated equipment.

Qualification information is to be submitted by July 26, 2013 and it is anticipated that Bid Documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about **September 2013**. In order to pre-qualify for this Contract, all participating firms must also execute and submit the Agreement on Terms of Discussion, the Non Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement, and the Contractor's Qualification Statement with their RTQ submittal package, as well as execute the Background Qualification Questionnaire and submit as per instructions.

Contract awarded from this Pre-qualification may be funded in whole or in part by the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA"). Accordingly, all Contractors must comply with the applicable provisions set forth in the Bid Documents, provided to all qualified bidders.
