The work generally consists of: Replacing (removing, disposing of, furnishing, and installing) existing transformers, airfield lights (provided by the Authority), existing bolts and lock washers on airfield lighting collars, existing damaged 5kv airfield lighting cables, and ground wires in conduits, cleaning secondary connections from light fixtures, and furnishing and installing concrete encased conduit duct banks.

Contracts awarded as a result of this RTQ may be funded in whole or in part by the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA). Accordingly, Contracts awarded as a result of this RTQ will contain Federal requirements and all qualified Firms that are awarded a Contract resulting from this RTQ must be able to comply with any and all of the applicable federal provisions set forth in the Indefinite Quantity Contracts.

Qualification information is to be submitted by mail or in person by June 5, 2014, no later than 4:00 pm and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders at the end of 2014. In order to pre-qualify for the RTQ 37825, all participating firms must also execute and submit the Contractor's Qualification Statement and the Agreement on Terms of Discussion with their package. Emailed or faxed submissions will not be accepted or evaluated.

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
