**Title: RTQ# 45394 – PATH – REPLACEMENT OF SUBSTATION NO. 9 – CONTRACT PAT-084.001**

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**Due Date: April 25, 2016**

The Work associated with the Contract referenced herein is located in Harrison, New Jersey, and involves replacement of PATH Substation No. 9 with new Substation and related utilities, infrastructure and connections to PSE&G service and PATH tracks, and removal of the existing PATH Substation No. 9. The scope of work includes construction of a two-story steel framed building for the new substation; furnishing, installation, and commissioning of three (3) 2000 kilowatt (KW) heavy duty traction power rectifiers, transformers, and switchgear; 38 kilovolt (KV) circuit breakers; medium voltage feeder cables; Direct Current (DC) switchgear; auxiliary power distribution system; Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and associated equipment. Work also includes sitework and utilities installations, and decommissioning and demolition of existing substation No. 9, including partial salvage of existing equipment.

**The PATH seeks firms to respond to RTQ# 45394 – PATH – REPLACEMENT OF SUBSTATION NO. 9 – CONTRACT PAT-084.001 following a 2 Step Bid process as follows:**

Step (1): Interested Bidders must respond to the referenced RTQ dated March 2016 in order to qualify to receive bids; and

Step (2): Bidders who meet the qualifications outlined in the referenced RTQ, and or deemed prequalified, will be invited, to submit lump sum bids.

Please note that the submission of qualifications under the referenced RTQ shall remain open until such time that bid documents, inclusive of plans and specifications are available to all prospective bidders. Firms will be qualified on a rolling, ongoing basis up to the issuance of the bid documents, currently contemplated to be on or about first quarter 2017. Firms are encouraged to submit their qualification information early, as the evaluation process will take time, provided all other requirements (such as meeting the information security pre-requisites) have been met, and may result in a delay to receipt of bid documents.

PATH anticipates releasing bid documents to the prequalified list, on or about November 2016, however, the RTQ due date shall remain open until notification of the RTQ Closing via future Addendum.

Qualification information is to be submitted starting April 25, 2016 and it is anticipated that Bid Documents will be available to prequalified bidders on or about first quarter 2017. In order to pre-qualify for this Contract, all participating firms must also execute and submit Attachment I (Terms of Discussion) and Attachment II (Non Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement and Acknowledgments) with their RTQ submittal as well as execute the Business Qualification Questionnaire and submit as per instructions.
