The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey intends to pre-qualify prospective bidders for the project listed below. The qualification information and instructions for submission for this project are available on-line at

Title: RTQ# 46089 - Removal and Replacement of Airfield Lighting Cables and Splices Damaged by Hurricane Sandy at New York Airports.

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Due Date: July 29, 2016

The work generally consists of:

Replacing (removing, disposing of, furnishing, and installing) existing transformers, airfield lights (provided by the Authority), existing bolts and lock washers on airfield lighting collars, existing damaged 5kv airfield lighting cables, and ground wires in conduits, cleaning secondary connections from light fixtures, and furnishing and installing concrete encased conduit duct banks.

The Port Authority seeks firms to respond to RTQ#46089: Removal and Replacement of Airfield Lighting Cables and Splices Damaged by Hurricane Sandy at New York Airports.

Step (1): Interested Bidders must respond to the referenced RTQ dated June 2016 in order to qualify to receive bids; and

Step (2): Bidders who meet the qualifications outlined in the referenced RTQ, and or deemed prequalified, will be invited, to submit lump sum bids.

Firms will be qualified on a rolling, ongoing basis up to the solicitation due date. Bid documents are currently contemplated to be issued on or about first quarter 2017. Firms are encouraged to submit their qualification information as early as possible, as the evaluation process will take time and provided all other requirements (such as meeting the information security pre-requisites) have been met, late date qualification submissions may result in a delay of the

issuance of bid documents to the firm. Firms should be aware that submissions received less than two weeks before the solicitation due date may not be qualified in time to receive the bid documents prior to the solicitation due date.

While this RTQ will remain open, as bid documents are anticipated to be available in 1st Quarter 2017, it is recommended that the Respondent submit their information in sufficient time so that the Authority received it no later than 4.00 p.m on July 29, 2016. In order to pre-qualify for this Contract, all participating firms must also execute and submit Attachment I (Terms of Discussion) and Attachment II (Non Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement and Acknowledgments) with their RTQ submittal as well as execute the Business Qualification Questionnaire and submit as per instructions. The completed BQQ should be submitted to the Office of Inspector General by the Submission date set forth in Section IV of the RTQ.

Contracts awarded as a result of this RTQ may be funded in whole or in part by the Federal Emergency Management Administration (“FEMA”). Accordingly, all Contractors will be required to comply with the applicable provisions set forth in the Bid Documents, which will be provided to all prequalified bidders.
