**Title: REQUEST TO QUALIFY – PATH – NEW YORK AND NEW JERSEY
FACILITIES – CHEMICAL GROUTING VIA WORK ORDER -

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Scope of Work:

The work under this contract generally consists of performing pressure grouting into concrete, soil, or rock to provide repairs to leaks and other damages using either cement or chemical grouts as needed throughout the PATH system including stations and tunnels. Additional scope and requirements will include, but not necessarily be limited to the following:

1. Perform pressure grouting into concrete, soil, or rock to fill voids and seal water leaks using either cement or chemical grouts.
2. Provide cutting, patching, and removal of existing construction as necessary to perform the pressure grouting.
3. Protect pedestrian traffic, existing adjacent utilities, and existing surfaces to remain and finished surfaces.
4. Work on active railroad at various tunnels and stations of the PATH system in New York and New Jersey while train service is operational.
5. Perform work in space-restricted areas.
6. Strict coordination with PATH facility forces, and other Contractors in order to limit disruption to the PATH passengers, train services, maintenance operations, and other ongoing construction.

Qualification information is to be submitted by **4:00 pm on October 23, 2015** and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about fourth quarter of 2015. In order to pre-qualify for the said contract, all participating firms must execute and submit the Attachment I – Agreement on Terms of Discussion, Contractors Qualification Statement with their RTQ submittal package.
