ABOUT THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ

We are unlike any organization in the world. Founded in 1921, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey builds, operates, and maintains many of the most important transportation and trade infrastructure assets in the country. The organization's expansive network of aviation, tunnel, bridge, bus terminal, rail, and seaport facilities is among the busiest in the country, supporting more than 550,000 regional jobs and generating more than \$23 billion in annual wages and \$80 billion in annual economic activity.

The Port Authority also owns and manages the 16-acre World Trade Center site, where construction crews are building the iconic One World Trade Center, which is now the tallest skyscraper in the Western Hemisphere.

The Port District is a region within a radius of approximately 25 miles of the Statue of Liberty.



AVIATION: A network of six airport facilities across New York and New Jersey that serve over 100 million passengers annually and provide the region with unsurpassed global access through the busiest aviation system in the nation.

PORT AUTHORITY – TRANS HUDSON (PATH): The rapid transit system that serves as the primary transit link between Manhattan and neighboring New Jersey, presently carrying 244,000 passenger trips each weekday.

PORT COMMERCE: A system of marine terminals across two states that comprise the Port of New York and New Jersey, the largest port by volume on the East Coast and third largest in the nation.

TUNNELS, BRIDGES AND TERMINALS: The critical series of road networks that connect New York and New Jersey through tunnels, bridges and bus terminals, permitting the safe, efficient and convenient flow of goods and people through the region.
