

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey is focused on ensuring a safe, secure, well-regulated work environment for all licensed for-hire vehicle drivers.

Drivers who offer rides inside of the airport are breaking the law.

First-time offenders may face a fine of \$1,500 and a sentence of up to 15 days in prison. Repeat offenders may face financial penalties of up to \$3,000 and a prison sentence of up to 90 days.

If you see drivers soliciting passengers for rides or individuals offering unsolicited guidance directing passengers toward unauthorized drivers, **do not engage them.**
