

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

The traffic story at SWF has not improved. August's seat capacity was down 5.1% and passenger traffic fell 4.2%. An additional concern is that August's decline included Allegiant, SWF's newest entrant, as it fell 7.3%. As some consolation, the rate of passenger decline continues to shrink, and Delta Air Lines gained 7.8% with 525 more passengers compared to same period last year. This is Delta's first monthly improvement since May 2014. For the airport to see a significant turnaround in the short term, JetBlue, the airport's dominant carrier, has to show gains. SWF's cargo was down 3.2% in August.
