Aviation Department

EWR achieved the highest growth rate among our airport system as total passenger traffic grew 7.8 percent (+262,278 passengers), while handling a record 3.6 million travelers. Growth was led by the international sector's solid gain of 8.8 percent. EWR also led our airport system in international seat expansion with a 9.2 percent improvement, up 116,508 seats. Growth was led by United's 31,914 added seats (+ 3.9 percent). The domestic sector, too, posted solid growth with a 7.4 percent gain, up 173,989 travelers. EWR also led the region in domestic seat capacity with an 8.6 percent jump – up 236,686 seats. Total freight traffic at EWR grew by 3.4 percent – up 2,086 tons. International cargo led with a 10 percent jump. Following five months of uninterrupted growth (including double-digit growth rates in January and February), domestic cargo registered a 0.1 percent dip.
