

Aviation Department

EWR's total passenger traffic reached a record 3.940 million travelers (+44,184 travelers/+1.1 percent). Growth was totally driven by the international sector's record 1.209 million passengers (+50,440 passengers/+4.4 percent), as domestic volume landed in negative territory. International seat capacity increased by 57,746 seats (+4.2 percent). United grew its seat capacity by 46,954 seats (+6 percent). EWR's domestic passenger traffic fell by a modest 0.2 percent (down 6,256 travelers). Following a 3.4 percent gain in March, EWR's total freight activity posted its second decline of 2019 (-2,880 tons/-4.4 percent). Domestic cargo (approximately 64 percent of EWR's total freight activity) grew moderately (+516 tons/+1.3 percent). EWR's international cargo volume plunged by 13.6 percent (-3,396 tons).
