EWR's total passenger traffic reached a record 3.097 million travelers (+2,899 travelers/+0.1 percent). The international sector's record 914,909 passengers (+14,200 travelers/+1.6 percent) drove all the growth as domestic passenger traffic fell. Carriers grew international seat capacity by 81,374 seats (+7.1 percent). Domestic passenger traffic dipped into negative territory (-0.5 percent/-11,301 passengers). EWR's total freight volume posted its fourth consecutive decline (-2,709 tons/-4.3 percent). Domestic cargo led the fall with a 1,921-ton drop (-4.8 percent). While United posted a 35.3 percent surge (+914 tons), ABX Air, FedEx, UPS, and Mountain Cargo jointly handled 2,714 fewer tons. International cargo fell by 3.4 percent (-788 tons). Though Emirates, Norwegian and FedEx together added 896 tons, UPS, Lufthansa, Air China and Air India together handled 1,589 fewer tons.
