EWR's total passenger volume traffic posted its first loss since May 2014's 2.4 percent dip (-74,986 travelers/-1.8 percent), as both domestic and international passenger traffic slightly underperformed. The domestic sector posted a 2.1 percent drop (-59,864 travelers).). JetBlue, Southwest and United jointly handled 101,029 fewer travelers. EWR's international passenger posted its first loss since March 2017 (-15,122 passengers/-1.2 percent). Norwegian (-8,974 travelers/-20.8 percent), Delta (-8,473 travelers/-99.2 percent) and Air India (-4,532 travelers/-19.8 percent) each carried fewer passengers. EWR's total freight activity bounced back from April's 4.6 percent fall (+2.6 percent/+1,814 tons). Growth was driven totally by the domestic sector's 8.5 percent climb (+3,865—the highest volume increase among our airports. The international sector registered an 8.1 percent dive (-2,051 tons).
