EWR's total passenger activity improved by 2.7 percent (+98,774 travelers) to a record 3.738 million passengers. Growth was totally driven by the domestic sector's record 2.565 million travelers (+4.4 percent/+108,753 passengers). Domestic seat capacity grew by 2.3 percent (+70,868 seats), producing in higher load factors. On the other hand, international passenger traffic inched into negative territory (-0.8 percent/-9,979 travelers) to 1.173 million passengers. Carriers grew their international seats by 3.3 percent (+47,506 seats – highest level increase among our airports). EWR's total freight traffic fell 3.8 percent (-2,598 tons), as both domestic (-4.4 percent/-1,922 tons) and international freight fell (-2.7 percent/-
