JFK continued to drive the region's total passenger growth with 207,357 additional travelers while reaching a new mark of 5.246 million passengers (+4.1 percent). The international sector's record of 2.859 million travelers led growth (+159,761 passengers/+5.9 percent—the highest growth rate among our airports). JFK also led our region's international seatS growth (+118,530 seats/+3.4 percent). Domestic passenger volume grew 2 percent (+47,596 travelers) to a record 2.386 million travelers. Domestic seats rose by 1.4 percent (+39,198 seats). Total cargo volume at JFK (which represents about 60 percent of the region's total freight) fell by 4.6 percent (-5,468 tons). The fall was led by the international sector's tenth consecutive monthly drop (-9,850/-10.2 percent). JFK's domestic cargo activity climbed by 20.8 percent (+4,382 tons).
