Total passenger activity at JFK recorded its second straight drop (-1.4 percent/-88,086 travelers - the biggest decline among our airports). JFK was the only facility that did not grow its domestic passenger, posting its third continuous decrease (-118,121 travelers/-4.5 percent) due to declines by American and JetBlue. Conversely, Delta and Alaska grew their passenger count. International passenger inched up 0.9 percent (+30,035 travelers). Delta (+72,368 travelers/+12.4 percent), JetBlue (+37,506 passengers/+8.4 percent) and Norwegian (+36,417 passengers/+33 percent) paced growth. International seats creeped up 0.9 percent (+36,174 seats). JFK's total freight activity plunged 8.7 percent (-10,340 tons). International cargo (about 80 percent of JFK's total cargo) led the decline with its second straight doubledigit plummet (-12 percent/-11,559 tons). In contrast, domestic cargo activity improved by 5.4 percent (+1,219 tons).
