Aviation Department

JFK established three records in 2019, becoming the only facility in our airport system to achieve eight consecutive annual records. The airport handled 62.5 *million travelers (+1.5 percent/+914,837 passengers).* JFK also served a record 34.3 million international passengers – more than any other U.S. airport – (+2.4)percent/+798,383 travelers). The domestic sector, too, had a record year with 28.2 million passengers (+0.4 percent/+116,454 travelers). JFK's freight volume posted a 6 percent dive in 2019 as it registered 12 consecutive monthly declines. The main driver of the 85,640-ton collapse was the dominant international sector's 8.7 percent dive. On the other hand, the domestic sector achieved its second consecutive year of solid growth (+5.6 percent). Because it accounts for just over 20 percent of the airport's total freight, the solid gain in domestic cargo activity could not offset the deficit experienced by the international segment.
