

**Aviation Department**

JFK led the region's total passenger growth as it added carried 373,325 passengers and set a record of 4.63 million travelers (+8.8 percent) a year after JFK's total passenger traffic in January 2018 was disproportionately affected by the disruptions caused by Winter Storm Grayson and a water main break. The international sector reached a new mark of 2.5 million passengers (+190,677 travelers/+8.3 percent). JFK also led the region in domestic passenger gain (+182,648 travelers) and growth rate (+9.4 percent), handling a record 2.13 million passengers. JFK was the only facility that grew its total cargo volume (+2,496 tons/+2.4 percent). Growth was driven entirely by the domestic sector's 17.3 percent climb (+3,419 tons). International freight traffic posted its seventh consecutive monthly drop (-923 tons/-1.1 percent).
