

JFK's total passenger activity fell by a modest 0.4 percent (-23,252 travelers). The domestic sector led the decline with 57,190 fewer travelers (-2.2 percent). American carried 130,352 fewer passengers (-28.8 percent) as it slashed 163,192 seats (-30.7 percent) due to runway construction-related constraints and the grounding of the 737 MAX. Though Delta added 87,292 passengers (+8.2 percent), this improvement did not fully offset the deficit caused by American's reductions. JFK was the only facility to grow both its international passenger traffic (+33,938 travelers/+1 percent) and international seats (+34,162 seats/+0.9 percent). JFK's total freight traffic posted its biggest fall of 2019 – down 7.5 percent (-8,976 tons). The international sector (which represents nearly 80 percent of JFK's total cargo) led the decline with an 11.5 percent dive (-11,226 tons). Conversely, domestic freight volume soared by 10.6 percent (+2,250 tons).
