

Aviation Department

JFK's total passenger volume reached a record 5.708 million travelers (+28,780 passengers/+0.5 percent). Growth was totally led by the international sector's bounced back from May's 0.02 percent dip to a new mark of 3.192 million travelers (+53,449 passengers/+1.7 percent). Delta led growth with 50,571 additional passengers (+9.2 percent). JFK's domestic passenger traffic inched into negative territory (-1 percent/-24,669 travelers). While Delta added 54,669 passengers (+5.1 percent), AA carried 78,570 fewer passengers (-19 percent). JFK's total freight traffic (which represents about 60 percent of the region's total cargo) fell by 5.5 percent (-6,682 tons). The international sector posted a 12.1 percent plummet (-12,106 tons). Domestic cargo activity posted a 26.2 percent surge (+5,424 tons).
