

Aviation Department

JFK paced the region's passenger growth as it added 347,781 travelers to a record 5.18 million passengers (+7.2 percent). The international sector led with 185,226 added passengers to a record 2.698 million travelers (+7.4 percent – the top growth rate among our airports). JFK also led our region's international seat capacity growth with 71,246 added seats (+2.1 percent). JFK also led our airports in domestic passenger gain (+162,555 travelers/+7 percent), while reaching a record 2.483 million travelers. Carriers their domestic seats by 3.8 percent (+106,714 seats – highest among our airports). JFK's total cargo activity (about 60 percent of the region's total) inched down 0.3 percent (-421 tons). The international sector registered its ninth consecutive monthly drop (-1,965/-2 percent). Domestic cargo improved (+1,545 tons/+7.2 percent).
