

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at JFK rose by 2 percent (+100,803 travelers) and reached a record 5.185 million passengers. The international sector set the pace with a 3.5 percent gain (+99,068 passengers) and reached a new mark of 2.963 million travelers. With international seats edging down 0.3 percent (-10,430 seats), the international sector saw fuller planes. Domestic passenger activity reached 2.222 million travelers (+0.1 percent/+1,735 travelers). Domestic seat capacity fell 2.5 percent (-68,200 seats), producing higher load factors. JFK's total cargo activity posted an 8.8 percent dive (-10,474 tons). The decline was driven by the dominant international sector, which accounts for over 80 percent of the airport's total freight volume, as it registered a 10.5 percent plunge (-10,181 tons). Domestic cargo traffic, too, underperformed (-1.3 percent/-293 tons).
