

Total passenger volume at LGA reached a new mark of 2.647 million travelers (+112,357 passengers/+4.4 percent—the highest overall growth rate among our airports). Growth was paced by the domestic sector's record of 2.469 million passengers (+4.4 percent/+104,081 passengers—tops in domestic passenger traffic among our facilities). The two main contributors were Delta (+84,541 passengers/+8.1 percent) and Southwest (+20,086 passengers/+9.2 percent). LGA also led our airports in domestic seat improvement (+45,864 seats/+1.5 percent). With American cutting 29,532 seats (-3.4 percent), Delta drove growth with 67,478 added seats (+5 percent). LGA's international passenger sector improved by 4.9 percent (+8,276 travelers). With international seats falling by 8.7 percent (down 19,542 seats), LGA experienced fuller planes. Air Canada slashed 18,480 seats (-14.5 percent), mostly to Toronto. Total freight traffic at LGA improved by 13.9 percent (+62 tons).
