### Aviation Department

LGA led our region's passenger improvement, while reaching an August record of 2.887 million passengers (+97,248 travelers/+3.5 percent – highest growth rate among our airports). The domestic sector led growth with a record 2.661 million passengers (+96,225 travelers/+3.8 percent). Delta (+73,472 passengers/+6.6 percent) and American (+39,007 passengers/+5.8 percent) paced growth. On the other hand, United handled 18,308 fewer travelers (-7.3 percent). LGA also led our facilities in domestic seat growth (+66,114 seats/+2.1 percent). Delta set the pace with 63,376 added seats (+4.5 percent). Following three months of underperformance, LGA's international passenger sector landed in positive territory (+0.5 percent/+1,023 travelers). WestJet (+2,685 passengers/+5.3 percent) and Delta (+1,669 passengers/+7.2 percent) saw improved passenger activity. American (-3,135 passengers/-10.8 percent) and Air Canada (-1,196 passengers/-0.9 percent) carried fewer travelers. LGA grew its cargo at a double-digit pace (+14.9 percent/+68 tons).
