Aviation Department

LGA's total passenger volume achieved a new mark of 2.034 million travelers (+31,401 passengers/+1.6 percent). Growth was led entirely by the domestic sector's record 1.895 million passengers (+35,737 passengers/+1.9 percent), as international passenger traffic fell. The two main contributors were Delta (+22,326 passengers/+2.9 percent) and AA (+11,476 passengers/+2.2 percent). Carriers grew their domestic seat capacity by 63,632 seats (+2.4 percent). Delta set the pace with 43,614 added seats (+3.9 percent). Boston, Chicago, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Grand Rapids, Pittsburgh and Tampa registered double-digit gains in seat capacity. On the other hand, LGA's international passenger sector fell by 3 percent (-4,336 passengers). Air Canada (-3,101 passengers/-3.7 percent) had its first decline in nearly a year, and WestJet (-2,816 passengers/-8.8 percent) had its 10th consecutive monthly loss of passengers. Though AA and Delta added a combined 1,581 travelers, this gain fell short of the total gap created by Air Canada and WestJet. LGA's total freight activity fell by 4.2 percent (-20 tons).
