

Aviation Department

LGA was the only facility with improved passenger traffic, adding 87,276 travelers for a July record of 2.827 million passengers (+3.2 percent). Growth was totally driven by the domestic sector's record of 2.617 million travelers (+3.7 percent/+93,137 passengers). Delta (+77,838 passengers/+7.2 percent) and American (+40,600 passengers/+6.1 percent) led growth. Conversely, United carried 19,011 fewer passengers (-7.4 percent). LGA also led our facilities in domestic seat growth (+92,074 seats/+3 percent). Delta led growth with 80,990 added seats (+6.1 percent). On the other hand, LGA's international passenger sector posted its second consecutive fall (-2.7 percent/-5,806 travelers). American (-15,314 passengers/-30.4 percent) and Air Canada (-8,136 passengers/-5.5 percent) handled fewer passengers. Delta (+6,277 passengers/+9.1 percent) and WestJet (+6,041 passengers/+12.9 percent) saw improved passenger counts, but those were insufficient to cover the losses experienced by American and Air Canada. Total cargo activity at LGA fell by 1.5 percent (-7 tons).
