## Aviation Department

As in the month of May, LGA set the pace for the region's overall passenger growth with 37,345 additional passengers as it set a new May record of 2.800 million travelers (+1.4 percent—the highest overall growth rate among our airports). The domestic sector led growth with a record of 2.597 million passengers (+1.7 percent/+44,564 passengers highest volume gain among our facilities). LGA also the only among our top three airports to grow its domestic seat capacity (+64,610 seats/+2.1 percent). Delta was the main contributor with 57,730 added seats (+4.3 percent). On the other hand, LGA's international passenger volume contracted (-3.4 percent/-7,219 travelers). Air Canada (-11,916 passengers/-9.6 percent) and American (-3,775 passengers/-19.1 percent) were the main contributors to the fall. Though WestJet grew its passenger volume at a double-digit clip (+15.1 percent/+6,655 passengers) this improvement was not sufficient to cover the deficit experienced by Air Canada and America.
