LGA's total passenger traffic grew to a record 2.590 million travelers (+169,319 passengers/+7 percent second highest growth rate among our airports). Growth was paced by the domestic sector's new mark of 2.419 million travelers (+153,354 passengers/+6.8 percent). Delta led growth with 102,378 added travelers (+10.4 percent). LGA saw higher load factors, as carriers grew their domestic seat capacity by a modest 0.9 percent). LGA's international passenger sector recovered solidly from its February's 3 percent dip, as it grew to a record 170,081 travelers (+15,965 passengers/+10.4 percent – highest growth rate among our airports). Air Canada bounced back solidly from its January's fall (+11,771 passengers/+13.6 percent). Delta (+2,949 travelers/+21.3 percent) and AA (+2,358 travelers/+13.6 percent) grew their respective passenger count at a double-digit pace. Conversely, WestJet continued to struggle (-1,113 passengers/-3.1 percent). LGA's total freight volume plunged 12.2 percent (-219 tons).
