

Aviation Department

LGA was the main driver of the region's passenger growth with 134,448 added travelers as it set a new May mark of 2.862 million passengers (+4.9 percent—the highest overall growth rate among our facilities). Growth was paced by the domestic sector's record of 2.661 million passengers (+5.7 percent/+142,353 passengers—top in domestic passenger traffic among our airports). LGA also led our airports in domestic seat growth (+136,778 seats/+4.4 percent). Delta drove growth with 79,530 added seats (+5.8 percent). American, too, made a significant contribution to LGA domestic seats growth with 44,950 extra seats (+5.2 percent). Conversely, LGA's international passenger activity fell by 3.8 percent (-7,905 travelers). Though WestJet carried 4,913 more passengers (+10.2 percent), Air Canada (-7,720 passengers/-7 percent) and American (-4,615 passengers/-23.1 percent) handled fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at LGA increased by 4.5 percent (+24 tons).
