Total passenger volume reached 2.7 million travelers (+29,470 passengers/+1.1 percent). Growth was led by the domestic sector's 2.5 million passengers (+38,534 travelers/+1.6 percent). Delta (+36,153 passengers/+3.5 percent) and American (+20,753 passengers/+3.1 percent) led growth. Conversely, United handled 12,668 fewer travelers (-5.5 percent). LGA led our facilities in domestic seat capacity growth (+81,900 seats/+2.6 percent). Delta set the pace with 51,646 added seats (+3.9 percent). LGA's international passenger traffic fell 4.4 percent (-9,064 travelers). Air Canada (-13,213 passengers/-10.9 percent) and American (-4,896 passengers/-24 percent) posted double-digit dips. Though WestJet (+6,801 passengers/+15.7 percent) and Delta (+2,244 passengers/+11 percent) achieved solid improvements, their combined gain fell short of the deficit experienced by Air Canada and American. LGA was the only facility to grow its freight volume (+68 tons/+12.1 percent).
