LGA was the main contributor to the region's passenger record performance (+159,886 passengers/+6.8 percent) to a new mark of 2.520 million travelers. Domestic passenger activity paced growth with a 6.9 percent jump (+150,034 travelers - the highest volume gain among our facilities) to 2.312 million travelers. Delta (+102,696 passengers/+11.5 percent) and American (+63,665 passengers/+11 percent) led growth with double-digit growth rates, as Spirit (-6,525 passengers/-5.8 percent), United (-6,150 passengers/-2.8 percent) and Frontier (-2,330 passengers/-7.9 percent) carried fewer passengers. With domestic seat capacity up 5.2 percent (+149,280 seats - highest increase among our facilities), carriers at LGA saw lower load factors. LGA's international passenger traffic reached a record 207,298 travelers (+9,852 passengers/+5 percent), despite reduced seat capacity (-3.8 percent/-9,214 seats). WestJet (+7,526 passengers/+18.1 percent) was the major contributor to growth. Air Canada grew its passengers moderately (+1.6 percent/+1,910 passengers). LGA's total freight traffic surged by 12.4 percent (+63 tons).
