Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's total passenger activity achieved a best-ever February with 9.305 million air travelers (+228,602 passengers/+2.5 percent). Growth was led by the international sector's new mark of 3.21 million passengers (+128,468 travelers/+4.28 percent). The domestic sector handled a record 6.095 million passengers (+100,134 travelers/+1.7 percent). Carriers grew total seats by 2.6 percent. International seats climbed 5.3 percent, while domestic seats gained 1.1 percent. The region's total freight activity posted its worst monthly performance in five years, losing 10,095 tons and down 5.8 percent as all four airports handled fewer cargo. International cargo (about 64 percent of our region's total) led the decline with a 7.4 percent plunge (-8,203 tons), falling for the fourth consecutive month. Domestic cargo, too, disappointed with a 3 percent fall (-1,892 tons). We had anticipated a slowdown in cargo traffic, but this sudden and sharp decline was unexpected.
