Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's total air passenger traffic posted its second consecutive monthly drop, down 0.8 percent (-109,054 travelers). For the first time since April 2013, both domestic and international passenger activity fell. The domestic sector led the fall with a 56,980-passenger decrease (down 0.7 percent), while airlines cut domestic seat capacity by 1.7 percent. International passenger volume fell 1 percent (-52,074 travelers). International seats decreased by 0.3 percent. The region's total cargo activity posted its second successive monthly drop (-6.8 percent/-12,857 tons - 2019's largest monthly decline. The international sector (representing over 60 percent of our region's total cargo volume) continues to struggle (down 11.6 percent/-14,383 tons). In contrast, domestic freight traffic showed improvement, albeit at a comparatively moderating pace (+2.3 percent/+1,526 short
