Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The region's total passenger volume achieved a new mark for the month of May with 12.520 million air travelers (+98,399 passengers/+0.8 percent). Growth was entirely driven by the domestic sector's record 8.043 million passengers (+138,474 travelers/+1.8 percent), though domestic seats grew by only 0.4 percent. For the first time since March 2017, international passenger traffic slid into negative territory (-40,075 travelers/-0.9 percent) as our airport system handled fewer international travelers in spite of a 1.1 percent gain in seats. Carriers grew total seat capacity by a modest 0.6 percent. The region's total freight traffic fell by 1.6 percent (-2,981 tons). International cargo (over 60 percent of our region's total) led the way down with a 6.4 percent drop (-7,776 tons). On the other hand, domestic cargo activity continues to grow solidly, achieving its third consecutive month of strong growth with a 7.2 percent bump (+5,042 tons).
