Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's total air passenger volume rose to a record 11.476 million travelers in the month of September (+333,353 passengers/+3 percent). The domestic sector led growth as it handled 7.124 million passengers (+256,858 passengers/+3.7 percent). With carriers growing their domestic seats by a modest 1.7 percent, our region experienced higher load factors. International passenger activity reached a record 4.352 million passengers (+76,495 travelers/+1.8 percent). International seat capacity was nearly flat (up 0.02 percent), leading to fuller airplanes. The region's total freight plunged 6.8 percent (down12,908 tons). While domestic cargo continues to show improvement (+3 percent/+2,043 tons), international cargo posted its 11th consecutive fall (-8.9 percent/-10,866 tons).
