SWF's total passenger activity fell by 7.1 percent (down 3,608 travelers). The international sector posted its third consecutive monthly decline (down 4,025 passengers/-17.8 percent), caused in part by the grounding of the Max-8 and strategic termination of operations to Belfast, Bergen, Edinburgh and Shannon. Conversely, Norwegian markedly increased its seats to Dublin (+76 percent/+10,056 seats). Domestic passenger activity inched up 1.5 percent (+417 travelers). Allegiant (+364 passengers/+4.6 percent) and JetBlue (+172 passengers/+1.8 percent) led growth, as Delta Connect-Skywest and American-Piedmont jointly carried 119 fewer passengers. Allegiant was the only carrier to grow its domestic seat capacity (+424 seats to Orlando/+1.3 percent). SWF's total cargo activity posted a 1.8 percent increase (+32 tons).
