MARCH 2019 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department
 For the second month in a row, SWF's total passenger volume landed in negative territory (-9.5 percent/-4,550 travelers). The fall was totally driven by the international sector's 4,588-passenger plunge (-22.9 percent). The domestic segment showed a 38-traveler improvement (+0.1 percent). Allegiant and Delta Connect together added 766 travelers, but JetBlue AA-Piedmont jointly carried 728 fewer passengers, resulting in a 38-passenger uptick. This modest gain was not sufficient to cover the hole caused by the international sector's second straight monthly fall, as Norwegian ended operations to Belfast and Bergen and reduced flights to Shannon (-90 percent). SWF's total cargo activity plunged by 10.8 percent (-219 tons).
