

Aviation Department

SWF's total passenger traffic posted a 43.4 percent plunge (-26,110 travelers). The international sector led the dive with 22,446 fewer travelers (-72.2 percent), reflecting the negative impact of Norwegian's termination of operations to Belfast, Bergen, Edinburgh and Shannon and its 40.6 percent seat capacity cut (down 9,212 seats) to Dublin - its last remaining international destination. SWF's domestic passenger volume, too, underperformed (-12.6 percent/-3,664 passengers). Allegiant led the nose-dive with a 62.6 percent plummet (down 5,026 passengers), as it cut seat capacity (-62.3 percent/-6,332 seats), mostly to Myrtle Beach (down 3,186 seats/-90 percent) and Punta Gorda (down 2,478 seats/-87.5 percent). SWF's total cargo volume improved by 5.7 percent (+101 tons).
