Total passenger activity at EWR fell by 98.3 percent (-3.873 million travelers). The domestic sector registered a 2.676-passenger tumble. United (-1.837 million passengers/-98.5 percent), JetBlue (-186,251 passengers/-95.3 percent), American (-162,437 passengers/-95.5 percent) and Delta (-144,972 passengers/-96.2 percent) led the dive with a combined 2.330-million-traveler loss. EWR's international passenger traffic recorded a 99 percent plunge (-1.197 million travelers). EWR's top carrier United transported 725,835 fewer passengers (-98.8 percent). Air Canada (-61,057 passengers/-99.5 percent), SAS (-41,695 passengers/-99.6 percent) and Lufthansa (-35,789 passengers/-96.8 percent) also experienced large shortfalls.

Total cargo activity at EWR plunged by 31.9 percent (-19,897 tons). The decline was driven by the international sector's second consecutive double-digit plummet (-59.3 percent/-12,681 tons). The domestic segment, too, posted a double-digit nosedive (-17.6 percent/-7,216 tons).
