

Aviation Department

EWR's total passenger activity posted the strongest performance relative to our other major commercial airports, recording a drop of -76.4 percent (-3.252 million travelers) compared to August 2019. The domestic sector saw its traffic fall by 70.8 percent (-2.007 million passengers). In order, United, American, Delta, and Alaska experienced a combined decline of 1.793 million passengers. International passenger traffic slumped by 87.4 percent. The 1.244-million passenger drop was led by United, Air Canada, SAS, Porter and Emirates which together carried 917,069 fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at EWR dropped by 17.6 percent (-11,502 short tons). The decline was driven in part by the international sector's 30.9 percent decline (-6,738 short tons). SAS and Emirates recorded double-digit tumbles (-2,597 short tons / 89.9 percent combined). EWR's domestic cargo volume fell 10.9 percent (-4,764 short tons).
