Aviation Department

EWR's total passenger activity posted the lowest percentage and volume drops among our airports (-82.3 percent/-3.41 million travelers). The domestic sector saw its traffic fall by 77.7 percent (-2.152 million passengers). In order, United, American, Delta and Alaska experienced a combined decline of 1.939 million passengers. International passenger traffic slumped by 91.6 percent. The 1.258-million passenger drop was led by United, Air Canada, SAS, Porter and Emirates which together carried 917,928 fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at EWR dropped by 13.4 percent (-8,694 tons). The decline was wholly driven by the international sector's 41.6 percent decline (-9,568 tons) as domestic cargo improved. United, SAS, Emirates, UPS and British Airways recorded doubledigit tumbles. EWR's domestic cargo volume posted its first improvement of 2020 (+2.1 percent/+874 tons). Kalitta Air, UPS and United (+503 tons/+17.5 percent) led growth with double-digit gains.
