Aviation Department

Total passenger plunged by 90.8 percent (-3.749 million travelers). The domestic sector served 2.375 million fewer passengers (-87.8 percent). United (-1.687 million passengers/-90.6 percent), Delta (-152,951 passengers/-90.3 percent), AA (-148,879 passengers/-76.9 percent) and Alaska (-102,269 passengers/-88.6 percent) served a combined 2.091 million fewer passengers. International passenger activity fell by 96.7 percent (-1.374 million travelers). United (-818,542 passengers/-96.7 percent), Air Canada (-67,754 passengers/-98.9 percent), SAS (-50,957 passengers/-97.8 percent), Porter (-39,108 passengers/-100 percent) and Emirates (-42,480 passengers/-100 percent) jointly carried 1 million fewer travelers. Total freight activity fell 21.6 percent (-14,269 tons). The international sector saw its fourth consecutive monthly loss (-45.9 percent/-10,577 tons). EWR's domestic cargo sector fell 8.6 percent (-3,692 tons).
