Total passenger volume fell 96.3 percent (-3.876 million travelers). The domestic sector served 2.689 million fewer passengers (-95.2 percent). United (-1.861 million passengers/-95.7 percent), American (-191,747 passengers/-93.4 percent), Delta (-148,545 passengers/-91.3 percent) and JetBlue (-137,987 passengers/-93.5 percent) led the shortfall. International passenger activity dropped by 98.9 percent (-1.187 million travelers). United (-690,018 passengers/-98.8 percent). Air Canada (-63,471 passengers/-100 percent), SAS (-44,629 passengers/-100 percent), Porter Lufthansa (-39,733 passengers/-100 percent) and Lufthansa (-34,365 passengers/-93.9 percent) carried fewer travelers. Total freight tumbled by 45.3 percent (-32,846 tons). The decline was driven by the international sector (-77.7 percent/-18,055 tons). United (-8,811 tons/-84.1 percent), UPS (-1,808 tons/-100 percent), Emirates (-744 tons/-100 percent), British Airways (-628 tons/-100 percent) and El Al (-611 tons/-100 percent) experienced deep deficits. EWR's domestic cargo sector posted a 30 percent fall (-14,791 tons).
