Total passenger activity posted the strongest relative performance among our major commercial airports, recording a drop of -65.1 percent (-2.399 million travelers) compared to November 2019. The domestic sector saw its traffic fall by 59.6 percent (-1.577 million passengers). In order, United, American, Delta, and Alaska experienced a combined decline of 1.508 million passengers. International passenger traffic slumped by 78.9 percent. The 822,706-passenger drop was led by United, SAS, Porter, Emirates, and Air Canada which together carried 585,394 fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at EWR fell by 5.1 percent (-3,459) short tons). The decline was driven in part by the international sector's 21.9 percent decline (5,750 short tons). EWR's domestic cargo volume rose 5.4 percent (2,291 short tons).
