EWR's total passenger activity posted the strongest relative performance among our major commercial airports, recording a drop of -69.8 percent (-2.762 million travelers) compared to October 2019. The domestic sector saw its traffic fall by 64.5 percent (-1.815 million passengers). In order, United, American, Delta, and Alaska experienced a combined decline of 1.63 million passengers. International passenger traffic slumped by 82.7 percent. The 946,209-passenger drop was led by United, SAS, Air Canada, Porter, and Emirates, which together carried 754,217 fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at EWR fell by 9.1 percent (-6,735 short tons). The decline was driven in part by the international sector's 24.3 percent decline (-6,423 short tons). EWR's domestic cargo volume fell less than 1 percent (312 short tons).
