Aviation Department

EWR's total passenger activity posted the strongest relative performance among our major commercial airports, recording a drop of (-75.3 percent/-2.832 million travelers) compared to September 2019. The domestic sector saw its traffic fall by 70.5 percent (-1.807 million passengers). In order, United, American, Delta, and Alaska experienced a combined decline of 1.625 million passengers. International passenger traffic slumped by 85.5 percent. The 1.024-million passenger drop was led by United, SAS, Air Canada, Porter, and Emirates which together carried 744,426 fewer travelers. Total cargo activity at EWR dropped by 8.7 percent (-5,808 short tons). The decline was driven in part by the international sector's 31.4 percent decline (-7,752 short tons). EWR's domestic cargo volume rose 4.6 percent (1,944 short tons) on the strength of gains from Federal Express (7.9 percent/1,970 short tons).
