As the airport system's leader in passenger traffic, it's no surprise that JFK led the loss in passenger traffic as the airport shed 5.136 million travelers (-98.4 percent) compared to 2019. Domestic passenger volume fell 98 percent compared to 2019 (-2.338 million travelers). In order, Delta (-1.012 million passengers/-98.5 percent); JetBlue (-833,233 passengers/-97.5 percent); and American (-356,279 passengers/-97.9 percent) led the fall as they jointly carried 2.202 million fewer travelers. JFK's international passenger sector fell by 98.8 percent (-2.797 million travelers). JFK's total freight volume posted another month of cargo underperformance (-38.2 percent/-42,865 tons – the biggest percent and volume falls among our airports). The decline was mainly caused by the international sector (which accounts for over 75 percent of JFK's total cargo traffic), which recorded a 42,484-ton loss (-49 percent). JFK's domestic cargo activity inched into negative territory with a 1.5 percent dip (-381 tons).
