Total passenger traffic fell by 73.4 percent for calendar vear 2020 (-45.920 million passengers) and 78.1 percent in December 2020 (-3.986 million), practically tied with LGA for the second-largest decline after SWF. The international sector (typically accounting for more than half of JFK's total passenger activity) saw its passenger volume sink by 80.5 percent (-2.196 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue, American, Norwegian, and Virgin Atlantic accounted for most of the losses as they jointly transported 942,923 fewer passengers. Domestic passenger traffic at JFK plunged 75.5 percent (-1.790 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue and American posted a combined loss of 1.650 million travelers. JFK's 2020 freight activity fell 13.9 percent versus calendar year 2019 (-185,813 short tons), but finished the year on a high note, booking an increase of 4.4 percent (4,942 short tons) compared to December 2019. Gains in domestic cargo (16,996 short tons/74.2 percent) more than offset declines in international cargo (-12,054 short tons/-13.6 percent).
